149 ASNs (Orgs), **328** attendees





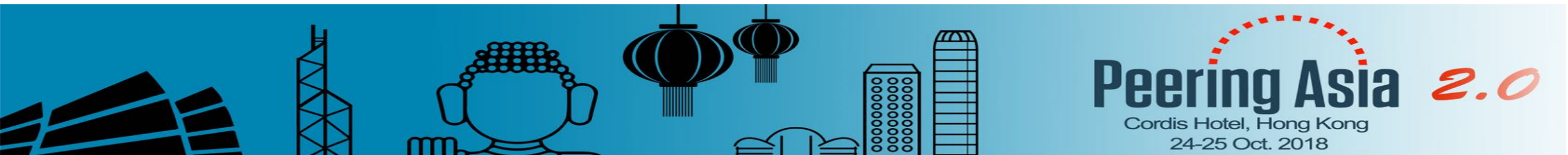
Thanks for the Hosts!
